Special meeting of Council at S. H. Crozer's House

The meeting was called by order of The Chief Burgess to take action in the matter of the suspension of the Policeman. The charge was that he did make his rounds to indicate his watch that he must have a key to open the watch or a set of keys to work the same and also that he at various times left his post without any authority to do so, and further he is not nor ever has paid proper attention to the lights or extinguishing to Boro lights and lastly that he is not a man of discretion to determine who should or should not be locked up or arrested.

After hearing the above report and discussing the same the Policeman was given a hearing in which he denied the above generally, stating that he had been policeman two years and had never left his beat but twice, and charging the police commissioner as being always opposed to him, but was unable to sustain the allegation in any particular after which on motion of R. H. Crozer he was placed on duty until regular meeting of Council.
