**DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY**  
**August 4, 2020**

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Borough of Upland, Delaware County, Pennsylvania effective August 4, 2020, lasting no more than ten (10) days.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to a severe tropical storm, Tropical Storm Isaias. Tropical Storm Isaias has caused severe flooding and dangerously impacted the health, safety and welfare of our residents and businesses in the Borough of Upland, Delaware County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, I, the undersigned Mayor of Upland Borough in Delaware County, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S. Section 7501), as amended do hereby proclaim the existence of a Weather Emergency in the Borough of Upland, Delaware County.

FURTHER, I direct the Upland Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, I authorize officials of the Borough of Upland, Delaware County to act as necessary to meet current demands of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Declaration shall take effect immediately.
