Those in attendance were well schooled.

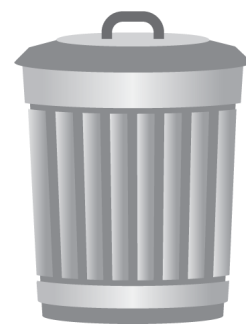


Trash Collection beginning in October

FOCUS ON UPLAND'S FIRST RESPONDERS

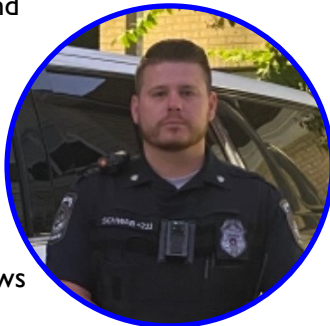


Officer Erik Schwab was hired by the UBPD in Oct., 2021 and is currently assigned to the patrol division.

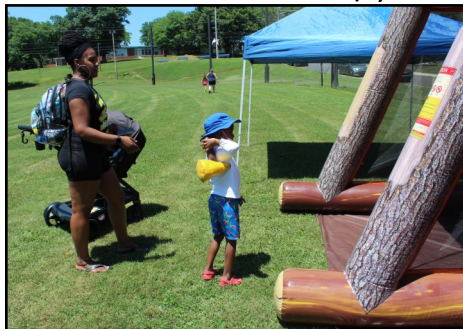
July 4th Celebration
