Each residents that wishes to sign-up or modify their current subscription, must:

• Go to website: www.uplandboro.org

• Click: E-Subscribe

• Click: Civic Ready (highlighted in blue)

• Click: **Sign-Up** if new to the system; or **Modify**

if currently receiving robo-calls

**Each person registered for the notification system can then download an app on your phone.

Residents can modify what they wish to be notified for at any given time. Examples: Events, Emergencies, Flood situations. According to what you choose in your profile, you will get notified by email, text and/or phone call.

"Growing up, I always wanted to be a police officer so I decided to get a head start by doing the citizen's police academy and an internship with the Radnor Police Department" said Officer Rish-Klemm.

In his youth, Sonny loved to work on cars and motorcycles. He used garages that his father-in-law opened on Main St. currently the site of the UAC. He was a millwright by trade and a self taught carpenter.

Sonny was a big part of UFC over the years maintaining the building and apparatus. Every year he would take one of his vacations to service all the apparatus, keeping them ready for emergencies. Even as Sonny got older he would take the trucks to get inspected or repaired.

At the Housing of the 1983 Mack fire truck in August 1983, Sonny was presented with Honorary Chief Engineer status and the Mack was dedicated in Honor of Sonny. This is only the second time in UFC history that this honor was given. He was also presented with Honorary Membership and received

Fireman of the Year twice.

Sonny held the following positions:
Engineer, Chief Engineer,
Trustee and Vice President.
After retiring, Sonny would be at the Fire House cutting the grass and maintaining the building, It was his second home.

Sonny passed away on May 3, 2023 and will truly be missed!
