RESOLUTION NO. 8 of 2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF UPLAND, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA CONTINUING AN EMERGENCY DECLARATION FOR DELAWARE COUNTY DUE TO THE EFFECTS OF THE COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS EFFECTIVELY CONTINUING PROCLAMATION 1 OF 2020 SIGNED ON MARCH 13, 2020.

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, in a joint proclamation of a State of Emergency was authorized by Borough Council and the Mayor beginning that day pursuant to the authority vested by 35 PA.C.S.A. § 7501(b) and the PA. State Borough Code, because of the severe damage anticipated to be caused by the effects of the COVID-19 Coronavirus in the Borough; and


WHEREAS, without further action by Upland Borough, such Disaster Emergency could expire seven (7) days after it's declaration, and the effects of the COVID-19 Coronavirus in the Borough of Upland are anticipated to continue for a period in excess of seven (7) days;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by authority of the BOROUGH COUNCIL of the BOROUGH OF UPLAND, DELAWARE COUNTY, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same, that UPLAND BOROUGH COUNCIL extends the above mention declaration terms of Proclamation 1 of 2020 until further notice or action of Council.


1. Holding this meeting on an emergency basis and taking an emergency action at this time is necessary to protect or promote the public health and safety of the Borough.
2. The effects of the COVID-19 Coronavirus in the Borough do constitute a clear and present danger to life and/or property.
3. The Disaster Emergency declared for the Borough under 35 Pa. C.S.A. § 7501(b) and the PA. State Borough Code shall continue until further action is taken by Borough Council to declare the end of such Disaster Emergency.
